Just as we were going to press Thursday, this came to our attention:

Hamtramck attorney Alexis Krot has been appointed by Gov. Rick Snyder to replace Hamtramck 31st District Court Judge Paul Paruk.

Paruk recently resigned to take a position with the State Supreme Court as an administrator.

Krot will fill the position until 2018 when an election will be held.

She has been serving as a magistrate for the court for the past few years and was one of six people who applied for the position.

“I am humbled and honored and look forward to serving the people of Hamtramck,” Krot told The Review.

For some Campau businesses, new sewer line is an economic stinker

Ali Mohammed wants to work.

The Yemeni barber sits in his shop on Joseph Campau and Council Street for hours, waiting for customers. He cleans obsessively – the mirrors, the floor, the chairs — then sits back down to stare out the window.

Sometimes he falls asleep, wakes up, realizes it doesn't matter one way or the other whether he's awake: no one comes in anymore.

It's the construction, Mohammed says, that keeps clients away. Since April 18, Hennessey Engineers has overseen a joint project by Dan's Excavating Inc. and Liquiforce to upgrade the sewer line along Joseph Campau, from Goodson to the north and Denton to the south.

The cost of this project is \$3.5 million, which came from a state loan.

That section of road was completely inaccessible to cars until last week, a half mile of cracked cement and orange traffic drums sending customers elsewhere. One lane is finally open, but the effects of the project persist.

The new line is a larger diameter designed to prevent the basement flooding that many Ham-

Incumbents are the winners in primary election

Two city councilmembers' hopes to climb the political ladder were dashed on Tuesday's Primary Election.

Both Councilmember Anam Miah and Mohammed Hassan did poorly in their attempts to knock out their incumbent office holders.

They didn't even do well among Hamtramck voters.

Like many other communities, Tuesday was not a good day to count on voters to participate in voting. Hamtramck's turnout was a little less than 1,000 – which is not even 10 percent of the total number of registered voters here.

Miah had the hardest challenge in trying to unseat Wayne County Commissioner Martha Scott. Scott has been in one elected office or another since the 1980s, making her one of the most entrenched politicians in Wayne County.

Miah garnered a total of 460 votes throughout the district, of which a little over 200 came from Hamtramck voters. He finished last in third place.

Scott even beat out Miah here in Hamtramck with 527 votes.

Miah blamed the lack of a local election issue on the ballot for the low turnout.

"It had nothing to do with the city at all," he said. "If we had a millage or something it would have helped."

Scott left all of her challenges in the dust, finishing with over 4,000 votes. The second-place finisher was R.L. Lemmons who received 705 votes.

Hassan finished fourth out of seventh place in his bid to unseat State Rep. Rose Mary Robinson, who also easily beat her challengers with 3,249 votes. Hassan received 319 votes.

Hassan said he wasn't surprised by the result because he did not campaign.

"But people still voted for me," he said.

As for his future plans, he said he is staying local.

"My focus is on the Hamtramck city mayor," he said.

"The people told me to do it, to focus on Hamtramck."

Next year's city election will feature the mayor's race and the city council seats for Hassan, Andrea Karpinski and Ian Perrotta.


Hamtramck voters also agreed with county voters in passing two millages extensions, one for the Detroit Zoo and another for county parks.

In the school board election taking place in the November General Election, Boardmember Salah Hadwan won't have any competition.

That's because Joseph Wylie, the only other candidate to seek the seat with four years remaining in its term, dropped out of the race last Friday.

Hadwan was appointed to fill the seat of former Boardmember Mohammad Huda who was kicked off the board after it was determined he was not a resident.

Boardmembers Hedy Shulgon and Jackie Starr will be facing challengers Jeff Salazar, Moortadha Obaid, Renee Savage, Lamont Stinson and Showkat Chowdhury.

School district showed courage to fight lawsuit

Give the Hamtramck Public School District credit for sticking to its principles (sorry, no pun intended).

The district stood up to a legal challenge posed by former School Boardmember Mohammad Huda. Huda was kicked off the board last January after a private investigator turned over a mountain of evidence showing that Huda was not a resident of the city. That revelation followed an investigation by

The Review that turned up similar evidence. But despite this overwhelming evidence, Huda went to court and sued the district. Thousands of dollars later, a Wayne County Circuit Court judge not only agreed with the district, but also said Huda perjured himself when he filed to become a candidate and claimed to be a resident. That admonishment clearly opens the door for the district to seek criminal prosecution, which it should do without hesitation.

We were already fed up with certain candidates trying to manipulate our elections in recent years by illegally handling absentee ballots.

And now there is this ultimate betrayal of the public's trust.

Thankfully, the public school district decided to stand up to this assault on the integrity of our elections.

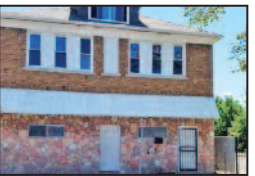

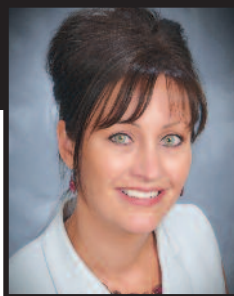


