





At 4 p.m. on election day, Councilmember Almasmari, who was in his first term, looked glum standing outside the polling precincts located at the Hamtramck High School Community Center.

He called out Chowdhurv. Hassan and Alsomiri for focusing on absentee ballot voters.

"That's not what a politician should do," he said. "I went and talked with voters."

He said those who rely on absentee voters are "snakes."

Chowdhury received the most absentee ballots at 643, with Hassan getting 638 and Alsomiri getting 533.

Almasmari received 334 absentee ballots, Lasley got 329 and Zwolak received 325.

There is nothing illegal in encouraging voters to vote by absentee ballot. In fact, the state recently made it easier for people to vote by

this method to encourage more folks to vote.

Turnout for the election was low, as expected considering the city council race was the only item on the ballot. Some 2,810, or 22 percent, people voted. out of a total of 12,383 registered voters.

August City Clerk Gitschlag said there were no incidents to report on election day.

"It was boring," he said about the day.

The state election law also allowed people to register and vote on election day. About 25 people took advantage of that, registering on Tuesday and then

voting. The new councilmembers' four-year terms start this Jan. 1 when they will join incumbents Ian Perrotta, Andrea Karpinski and Fadel Al-Marsoumi.

They, and Mayor Karen Majewski, will be up for reelection in two years.




